

To Whom it May Concern,

The John S. McCain [National Defense Authorization Act](#) (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2019 is a United States federal law that specifies the budget, expenditures, and policies of the U.S. Department of Defense. Section 889 of that law prohibits the U.S. government, federal agencies, their contractors and grant or loan recipients from procuring or using “telecommunications and video surveillance equipment or services” from specific Chinese companies as a “substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system.” ComNet has no relationship with the Chinese companies listed under Section 889 of the NDAA and ComNet branded devices do not contain any component parts manufactured by any entity banned under Section 889 of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019.
